MASS VACCINATION SITES & MARYLAND VACCINE FINDER

Maryland has established mass vaccination sites at Six Flags America, The Baltimore Convention Center, M&T Bank Stadium and plans to open a site mid-March at Regency Furniture Stadium. You can schedule an appointment for these locations and view all vaccination sites statewide through Maryland's COVID-19 Vaccine Finder. Scan the QR Code for more details. You will need to meet current criteria in order to register for a vaccine. TIP: Text MDReady to 898-211 to sign up for text alerts, including when vaccine appointments are available at mass vaccination sites. You will have to act quickly as appointments fill fast.
